- Erasmus Research Institute of Management (ERIM) founded in 1999.
- Unites the researcher in management of
 - the Rotterdam School of Management (RSM) and
 - the Erasmus School of Economics (ESE).
- Total of about 300 researchers at Erasmus:
 - 190 Fellows/Members (70% RSM, 30% ESE),
 - ca. 100 PhD students (65% international),
 - ca. 30 MPhil students (80% international).
- One of the largest Doctoral Programmes in Management in Europe.
- Research Institute and Graduate School (MPhil + PhD) in one integrated organization.
- Strong focus on the academic career of ERIM members.


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- Maturing into a leading research institute in Research in Management.
- Output & citation impact (bibliometric studies, 1999-2006):
 - Top 3 in Europe (with LBS and INSEAD).
 - Top 25 World-wide (Wharton School, Stanford, Harvard, NYU, Columbia, Duke, MIT, UCLA, ...).
- ERIM Research Programmes: 5 domains:
 - Business Processes, Logistics and Information Systems
 - Organization
 - Marketing
 - Finance & Accounting
 - Strategy
- ERIM Doctoral Programme:
 - Matches structure and mission of the research programmes.


- Policy of ERIM is done by performance incentives.
- Actively stimulating quality research:
 - 0.4 fte research voucher for regular members,
 - 0.6 fte research voucher for high performing members.
- Regular membership requirements:
 - 5 publications in 5 years.
 - At least 1 publication in a core Top journal ranked P or P* (see ERIM Journal List (EJL: www.erim.eur.nl/ejl) for ranking of journals into P*, P, and S journals).



 Output & Impact ERIM and 20 benchmark institutions (period 1999-2006, nucleus set of 80 core ISI journals; source CWTS).



 Output and impact ERIM and 20 benchmark Institutions (nucleus set Jnls; resulting from international cooperation; 40% of ERIM publ.).



- Fundamental parts of ERIM policy :
 - Combining the impact strategy for research and the ERIM Doctoral Programme.
 - Bring the doctoral students as close as possible to the publishing and citation network dynamics.
 - Service top research.

- ERIM = Quality Doctoral Programme.
- Main characteristics ERIM Doctoral Programme:
 - Highly selective, tested, multiple entries (Honours, MPhil, PhD).
 - Full & Coherent advanced course programme modeled to that of Top Business schools:
 - + Research Methodology (quantitative modeling, experimental design, case study research, survey design, ...).
 - + Skills training (writing, publishing, presenting, ...).
 - + Substantive courses per field.
 - Tailor made, nurturing variety.




- Main characteristics ERIM Doctoral Programme:
 - Participation in internationally active research community (for example, 180 research seminars in 2008; 90% outside speakers).
 - Benefiting from excellent research infrastructure & effectively organized research support programme.
- Annual output Doctoral Programme:
 - 35-40 PhD theses published in the ERIM PhD Series in Research in Management




Global positioning the ERIM Doctoral Programme:



Entry points, curriculum, and time line:




 ERIM study model MPhil research masters: transformation of learning modes: Knowing > Experiencing > Doing






 ERIM study model: transformation of networking dynamics: from doctoral student to early career researcher





Time line PhD (4-year model)






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
2. The ERIM Doctoral Programme

Time line PhD (3-year model for MPhil graduates)



- Courses (40 ECTS) in the 4-year PhD programme are quite flexible.
 - Course programme is adapted to the individual needs of the PhD.
 - Courses can be internal (ERIM courses) or outside ERIM (LNMB, Kurt Lewin Institute, etc).
 - ERIM courses are taught by

Number of external courses provided by LNMB per year:



 LNMB ranks first with 65 courses in 5 years, KLI ranks second with 59 courses in 5 years.



- Courses (40 ECTS) in the 4-year PhD programme are quite flexible.
 - Course programme is adapted to the individual needs of the PhD.
 - Courses can be internal (ERIM courses) or outside ERIM (LNMB, Kurt Lewin Institute, etc).
 - ERIM courses are taught by ERIM top researchers.
- Compulsory skill courses (6 ECTS):
 - English.
 - Publishing Strategy.
 - Presentation.
- Other courses:
 - Advanced specialization courses.
 - Advanced methodology courses.



- The aim is to educate PhD-students to become internationally competitive junior researchers.
- Measures and incentives to stimulate and challenge students:
 - 40 ECTS individual course programme.
 - Peer reviewed research proposal after one year.
 - Bring students as quickly as possible in 'publication mode' by sending in papers to international peer-reviewed journals.
 - Stimulate students to present work at international conferences (all costs are refunded when giving a presentation).
 - Stimulate international research visits (1/3 of costs of for maximally 4 months research visit).
 - Financial support programmes available for data collection, experiments, databases, etc.
 - Providing research facilities that are internationally competitive.



- MPhil research masters students:
 - Pay tuition fee (as normal students do).
 - In year 1: a limited number scholarships are available.
 - In year 2: personal research assistantships.
- PhDs are paid employees.
- PhD expenses and funding:
 - Courses, travelling abroad, conferences and seminars:
 - + ERIM support programs (ESP).
 - + 50/50 matching principle (ERIM and department share costs).
 - Literature € 700 for the three or four year PhD period.



- ERIM Support Program for PhD Students (ESP 10)
 - Conference participation (max. \in 1000 when presenting a paper).
 - Working visit to a conference (max \in 700, only once).
 - Working visit to an international university/supervisor (max € 1000).
 - Field research data collection (max \in 2500).
 - Courses (100% if part of Training and Supervision Agreement).
 - Scientific literature (€ 700 for a period of four years).
- ERIM PhD Series 'Research in Management' (ESP 11)
 - Publication of the PhD Thesis.



4. Career Support

- For PhD students:
 - Academic and generic skill courses:
 - + Publishing Strategy.
 - + Presentation Skills.
 - + English.
 - Special career course (Strategies for Successful Academic Placement):
 - + By experienced presenters (former AOM Directors of Placement).
 - + Incl. individual CV/cover letter reviews and advice sessions.
 - ERIM Support Programme nr. 10:
 - + International job market visit (to a max. of EUR 700) for last-year PhD candidates.



4. Career Support

- For PhDs and alumni:
 - ERIM Alumni Association:
 - + Website with useful links.
 - + Career workshops and discussion meetings.
 - Grant Applications:
 - + Grant Workshops.
 - + Advice and help with grant applications.
 - Tenure track programme:
 - + Qualification to high performing ERIM member and associate professor in 4 to 6 years.
 - Early carreer talent programme:
 - + Aimed at highly talented young researchers (post PhD).
 - + Extra research time (in 4 years: 0.9, 0.8, 0.7, 0.6 fte research).
 - + Three or four years.

5. Conclusions

- Success of the ERIM Doctoral Programme lies in integration of research of the staff and the Doctoral Programme.
- ERIM policies are directed to service the researcher (e.g., by providing research facilities, financial support, etc.).
- ERIM aims at stimulating and challenging PhD students by service and incentives.
- Incentives for high quality research.
- Creating an upward spiral:
 - Top research is rewarded.
 - Integrate doctoral programme with research.
 - Attracts top researchers.
 - Attracts better students.
