The new chair is expected to enthusiastically lead the group, contribute to the development and design of education programs, further strengthen the position of the group in national and international networks, stimulate innovative research, acquire funding, supervise PhDs, maintain close contacts with other universities, research institutes and enterprises, and manage the group's internal processes and relations in an effective and constructive way.

The chairgroup Operations Research and Logistics (ORL) is part of the Social Science Group (SSG) of Wageningen University and positioned within the section "Management Decision Support group" together with "Business Economics" and "Information Technology" groups.

The chairgroup ORL consists of 7 fte staff and about 10 PhDs. The mission of the group is to design effective logistics systems with a robust performance in the domain of agrifood supply chains, and to contribute to the state of the art of operations research and logistics. The group has a prominent position in the international field for its integrated approaches and its development of operations research and logistics concepts and models in the area of agrifood supply chains. In June 2015, the group has been assessed by an international peer review Committee that qualified the research quality, relevance to society and viability as excellent.

The group focusses on three central themes in research and education:

Quality Controlled Logistics (QCL): production planning and inventory management of perishable products; sourcing strategies for perishables; design of responsive fresh supply chain networks; reduction of postharvest losses in food supply chains.

Sustainable Logistics Management (SLM): closed loop supply chain management; reuse/recycling of packaging waste; green logistics; biobased economy; sustainability assessment and evaluation; resource efficiency.

Modelling and Solution Approaches (MSA) for efficient decision support: simulation driven optimization; multi-objective optimisation; pareto-optimality; compromise programming; constraint dynamic and linear programming; hybrid modelling approaches and heuristics.
